Bhopal: As a Tourist Spot

Bhopal, the Capital City of Madhya Pradesh, is known as the City of Lakes for its various natural and artificial lakes and for being one of the greenest cities in India. In the 'Swachh Survekshan 2021', it has been ranked as 7th cleanest metropolitan city of India after Indore, Surat, Vijaywada, Navi Mumbai, Pune and Raipur. Bhopal was founded by the Parmar King of Dhar, Raja Bhoj (1010-53) and named after him. Bhojpur, 28 km from Bhopal is renowned for the remains of its magnificent Shiva Temple and Cyclopean dam. The temple is known as the Bhojeshwar Temple. Upper Lake, initiated by Raja Bhoj almost 1000 years ago, is one of the chief sources of drinking water, fish, and water chestnuts. Modern Bhopal city was part of *Gond Kingdom* ruled by Queen, *Rani Kamlapati*, who was the last Hindu ruler and died in 1723. Her death led to Nawab rule in Bhopal. In Madhya Pradesh, the Gonds are the second largest tribal group after the Bhils. The Safari Park, Chowk Market, Shaurya Smarak, Anthropological Museum, Tribal Museum, State Museum, and Bharat Bhawan, a Centre for Performing and Visual Arts are major hotspots for visitors. Bhimbetka, just 45 km away from Bhopal is a group of 500 caves belonging to different periods of stone age.

IEA is a registered body of Indian Economics professionals, established way back in 1917, with the objective of providing a forum for debate and discussion of theoretical and policy oriented issues in Economic Science. Thanks to the initiative taken by Charles Joseph Hamilton, then Minto Professor of Economics at Calcutta University, and a score of economists, mostly teachers, who met in Calcutta in December 1917 to deliberate on economics. IEA is the oldest Association in Social Sciences and perhaps second oldest in the country in any discipline, after the Indian Science Congress Association (founded in 1914). IEA organizes annual conferences, seminars, and lectures by eminent persons of the profession. It stands for promoting the interest of the discipline in terms of extension, expansion and professional competence in teaching, training, research, and consultancy. It promotes the interests of its members, but more than that the interest of the public, which is served when members sincerely devote their time and energy to raise their competence and deploy that competence when the occasion arises. IEA has so far organized 103 annual conferences in different parts of the country.

Registration

There will not be any SPOT Registration. Registration Fee is Rs. 2000, which includes food and accommodation from 24 Dec 2021 (evening) to 28 Dec 2021 (morning). Separate Fee of Rs. 2000 is charged from accompanying spouse and children above 10 years of age. Organizers will not be responsible for accommodation and food of any accompanying person other than spouse. The conference kit will be given to delegates only and not their accompanying persons. **For Local Participants, not requiring accommodation, the Registration Fee is Rs. 1000/- only.**
